Parents/Guardians of the Classes of 2017 and 2018:

A law was passed which requires schools to provide directory information to all branches of the armed services each year by September 30. The only exceptions are students who have on file a signed request by their parents/guardians asking that the directory information (name, address, and phone number) not be given to the four branches of the armed services. After this year, the signed request must be made by the end of the student's sophomore year.

If you do not want your son's/daughter's information released to the armed services, please write a note stating that you respectfully request that the military not have access to your child's student directory information. If this request is not received prior to September 30, directory information for your child will be provided as requested.
